

Travel Update March 11, 2020--Fresno Unified is working alongside the Fresno County Department of Public Health as we all continue to monitor COVID-19. While the CDC and state of California have not placed any travel restrictions in the U.S., Fresno County Public Health is recommending local districts postpone/cancel travel to counties that have 10 or more confirmed cases.

While the health risk to the general public in California from COVID-19 continues to remain low, some of these counties are implementing plans to reduce community gatherings and large events and we want to help honor that effort.

Based on 10 or more confirmed cases, we are cancelling or postponing class, club, and team trips to the following counties: Santa Clara, San Francisco, Contra Costa and parts of Los Angeles (excluding Long Beach and Pasadena).

Today, we began working with school sites and departments to cancel trips into those counties. We expect that we will be adding to this list so we encourage parents and staff stay informed and up to date by visiting fresnounified.org.
