

Hello Edison Parents

Happy New year's and welcome back to semester two of 2021. I hope you had a restful, safe and healthy holiday break with your families in view of the increase of COVID-19 cases in California. The Edison family send prayers to families impacted by the virus. The number of positive COVID cases continue to increase here in Fresno County prompting a Stay at Home Order by the Governor. There are three times more confirmed cases since our last day of the fall semester and those numbers are only expected to increase with cases from Christmas and New Year's. **Because of this, all students are going to start the second semester this Tuesday, Jan 12 and will continue learning from home in a distance learning format.** We don't know exactly when the stay at home order will be lifted, we absolutely plan to bring small student cohorts back to campus in a reasonable time period once that occurs. We will continue to keep you updated. Knowing that internet access may have been a challenge previously, we want to make sure you have what you need to start smoothly on Tuesday. We're keeping schedule changes to a minimum due to the distance learning format and maintaining class size numbers. Schedule changes will only occur under special circumstances.

Reminder **New school schedule for Semester 2.** Please go to Edison's website to review translated versions of the new schedules.

Please note:

- Weekday morning M-F 8am-9am will remain with the Grab and Go meals provided for students and teachers sending out or posting the "week at a glance" for their classes so that students can view the expectations for the week. Every Tuesday is set aside for student/family connections. This 8-9am time allocated for scheduled discussions between teachers and students/parents/guardians. This includes scheduling and participating in parent/guardian meetings, SST/IEP/504 meetings, making phone calls home for students who are not participating and/or who need additional support, and connecting with students.
- **Every Monday** students must attend an Advisory period at 9am – 9:30am. Attendance is taken by teachers and it is **mandatory for students to attend Advisory**. SEL learning will be the focus during Advisory. The rest of the day students will work independently on asynchronous work. Students must check the week at a glance to locate their asynchronous work that must be completed for each class during the week. There is no instruction (other than SEL during Advisory) provided for students on Mondays, however, teachers may identify students and require them to meet for academic intervention supports. This will begin as soon as it is safe to do so. In-person targeted student interventions will begin when we move into the Orange Tier.
- **Tuesday's – Friday's** students will attend 75-minute odd/even block period classes. Periods will rotate each day from period 1, 3, 5, 7 on one day, then to period 2, 4, 6 on the next day continuing through out the semester. Remember on Tuesdays from 8-9am, teachers are available for student and family connections. Tuesdays are set aside for teachers

to reach out to parents/guardians to discuss student's academic progress. Parents may also initiate contact with teachers on Tuesdays.
