PARENT/COACH COMMUNICATION GUIDE

Both parenting and coaching are extremely difficult vocations. By establishing and understanding of each position, we are better able to accept the actions of the other and provide greater benefit to children

Communications you should expect from your child's coach:

1. Philosophy of the coach
2. Expectations the coach has for your child as well as all the players on the squad
3. Locations and times of all practices and contests
4. Team requirements, i.e. practices, special equipment, out of season conditioning
5. Discipline that may result in the denial of your child's participation

Communication coaches expect from parents:

1. Concerns expressed directly to the coach
2. Notification to the coach of any schedule conflicts well in advance
3. Specific concerns with regard to the coach's philosophy and/or expectations

Appropriate concerns to discuss with coaches:

1. The treatment of your child, mentally and/or physically
2. Ways to help your child improve
3. Concerns about your child's behavior

Issues NOT appropriate to discuss with coaches:

1. Playing time
2. Team strategy
3. Play calling
4. *Other students/athletes*

When you have a concern to discuss with the coach, this is the recommended procedure you should follow:

1. Call to set up and appointment.
2. If the coach cannot be reached, call the athletic director (451-4064). A meeting will be set up for you.
3. NEVER attempt to confront a coach before or after contest or practice. These can be emotional times for both the parent and the coach. Meetings of this nature do not promote resolution. **No meeting will be scheduled until the day after the incident or contest.**

THE NEXT STEP

What a parent can do if the meeting with the coach did not provide a satisfactory resolution:

1. Call and set up an appointment with the Athletic Director (451-4064) to discuss the situation.
2. If you are still not satisfied set up an appointment with our Vice Principal in charge of Athletics (451-4000).

NCAA INITIAL ELIGIBILITY

If you are planning to enroll in college as a freshman and you wish to participate in Division I or II athletics, you must be certified by the NCAA Initial Eligibility Clearinghouse. For more information, please contact your counselor (451-4000).

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Hoover High Sports Packet which includes a sports physical taken on/after **May 1, 2020** must be on file before the first practice. **All paperwork on www.familyID.com**
2. Eligibility clearance from previous and current semesters. Student must have received credit in a minimum of four classes and attempted a minimum of five classes AND posted a minimum 2.0 GPA in the last semester, or can be placed on probation if eligibility was met in the previous quarter.

ATTENDANCE DAY OF CONTEST

Students must attend at least half the day of school in order to participate. Excused absences can waive this.

TRANSPORTATION POLICY

1. In most cases, teams will use school transportation to away contests unless otherwise authorized by the school administration.
2. All players must travel on the bus with the team to and from away contests, unless all the following provisions are met:
 - a. AD/Coach's permission
 - b. Parent must take responsibility, in person after the contest
 - c. Parent must provide a note to the coach, or signature on sign out sheet
